

ORDINANCE NO. 12

AN ORDINANCE RELATING to the parking of Vehicles within the Borough of Mill Village at the intersection of U.S. Route #6 and Main Street.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Mill Village, of the County of Erie and State of Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION I

It shall be unlawful for anyone, at any time, to park any automobiles, trucks, tractors, mobile homes, vehicles, trailers, machinery or any other objects along the right-of-way of U.S. Route #6 and along the right-of-way of Main Street within the areas designated as follows:

- (1) Within that area along the south line of U.S. Route #6, extending twenty-three (23) feet westerly from the west line of Main Street;
- (2) Within that area along the north line of U.S. Route #6, extending 50 feet westerly from the west line of Main Street;
- (3) Within that area along the west line of Main Street, extending twenty-five (25) feet northerly from the north line of U.S. Route #6
- (4) Within that area along the east line of Main Street, extending twenty-five (25) feet northerly from the north line of U.S. Route #6
- (5) Within that area along the east line of Main Street, extending eighty-five (85) feet southerly from the south line of U.S. Route #6;
- (6) And within that area along the west line of Main Street, extending twenty-three (23) feet southerly from the south line of U.S. Route #6.

SECTION II

The Borough of Mill Village shall install proper signs and maintain the same for the purpose of giving notice to the public that the areas designated herein are no-parking areas.

SECTION III

Any person who violates the provisions of this Ordinance shall upon summary conviction before a Magistrate be sentenced to pay a fine of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars and costs of prosecution and in default of payment thereof shall undergo imprisonment for five (5) days.

SECTION IV

Should any part of this Ordinance be held invalid by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction, the remaining parts shall be severable and shall continue to be in force and effect.

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the same affect this Ordinance.
