

**ORDINANCE NO. 20**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MILL VILLAGE, ERIE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PROVIDING FOR THE AUDIT OF THE ACCOUNTS OF SAID BOROUGH BY AN INDEPENDENT AUDITOR APPOINTED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF SAID BOROUGH.

The BOROUGH OF MILL VILLAGE, by authority of the Act of February 1, 1966, P.L. 1656, No.581, § 1005, as amended, 53 P.S. (46005(7)), ordains as follows:

**Section 1.** From and after the effective date of this Ordinance, all of the accounts of the Borough of Mill Village for the year 1987, and all subsequent years, shall be audited by an independent Auditor appointed each year by the Borough Council of Mill Village pursuant to the provisions of the Act of February 1, 1966, P.L. 1656, No.581, § 1005, as amended, (53 P.S. 46005(7)).

**Section 2.** Such Auditor shall be a certified public accountant or firm of certified public accountants registered in Pennsylvania.

**Section 3.** Such Auditor shall be appointed annually by Resolution of Borough Council prior to the close of the fiscal year to make an independent examination of all the accounts and accounting records of the Borough for the fiscal year then closing.

**Section 4.** The compensation to be paid such Auditor shall be fixed by Borough Council.

**Section 5.** The powers and duties of the independent Auditor shall be as set forth in Section VII of the Act of February 1, 1966, P.L. 1656, No.581, § 1005, as amended, (53 P.S. 46005(7)), the text of which section is hereby adopted and incorporated by reference and made a part of this Ordinance to the same extent as though the same were set out verbatim.

**Section 6.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.
