

ORDINANCE NO. 28 of 1999

SIGNS

This article shall be known and may be cited as “Mill Village Borough No. 28 of 1999”. This article is enacted in conjunction with and under the authority of and within the forms of provisions of the Act of Assembly of the Commonwealth known as the “Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code” as amended.

1. Statutory authority

This article is enacted pursuant to the provisions of 75 Pa. C.S.A. & 6109(d), 75 Pa. C.S.A. & 6109(e), Title 67 of the PA Code, Chapter 610, & 610.42 and 75 PA. C.S.A. & 6122.

2. Purpose

The purpose of this article is as follows: to provide for the erection of stop signs, speed signs, weight signs, and any other signs or devices used to warn motorists or pedestrians of restrictions on any street or intersection within the borough of Mill Village.

3. Warning signs

It is further provided that warning signs, if needed, shall be erected on the various roads at a sufficient distance from the aforesaid signs to warn approaching motorists of the erection of said signs.

4. Violations and penalties

Any person operating a vehicle who fails to stop for a sign herein provided for shall be guilty of a summary offense pursuant to 75 Pa. C.S.A. & 6502 and shall be sentenced to pay a fine of \$50.00 to \$200.00.

5. Erection or Removal of Signs

Council shall have the authority to designate any intersection or applicable area for the erection or removal of an approved sign by Resolution of the majority of Council. Following authorization by Council, the manager shall gain all necessary approval from the Department of Transportation in order to comply with all applicable statutes

6. The Damaging, Defacing, Removing, Etc. of Signs

- A. It shall be unlawful for any person to deface, damage, knock down, remove, obstruct, injure, destroy or interfere with any traffic signs, guide post, warning sign, weight sign or marking placed in accordance with the provisions of this chapter and/or the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in, upon, along, or near the public highway or street in the borough of Mill Village.
- B. Any persons violating any of the provisions of this article shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall forfeit and pay a fine of not less **that** \$50.00 for more than \$200.00 with all cost of prosecution, together with the value of such signs so removed, destroyed, defaced, etc. and in default of payment thereof shall undergo an imprisonment in the jail of the proper county for a period not exceeding ten (10) days at the discretion of the court.

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7. The within Ordinance shall take effect upon final approval by Borough Council, signature by the Mayor and advertising according to law.
