

ORDINANCE NO. 6

An ordinance Approving and Establishing the Grades, Structures, and All other Structures Appearing on the Plan of the Department of Highways of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

WHEREAS, The Department of Highways has submitted to the Borough Council of Mill Village Borough a Plan showing the proposed construction of a portion of State Highway Route No. 709 on Center Street, from Station 1328 & 32 and Station 1381 & 28 a distance of 5296 feet, as shown by the said plan prepared and submitted by the Department of Highways, approved February 23, 1968, by the District Engineer of the Department of Highways.

SECTION I

Be it enacted and ordained by the Town Council of the Borough of Mill Village and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same, that the grades, drainage structures, and all other structures shown on the plans prepared and submitted by the Department of Highways as aforesaid, be, and the same are adopted, and are hereby enacted and ordained as and for the true and proper grades, drainage structures, and other structure of and for Center Street, as shown on the said plan, which is hereby adopted as the Official Borough Plan for the Said Street.

SECTION II

The President of the Borough Council and the Mayor are hereby authorized to express the approval of the Borough to the change of the grade of the aforesaid State Highway Route, by affixing their signatures, and the Borough Seal, to the said relocation plan.

SECTION III

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith be and the same are repealed.

SECTION IV

This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its approval as provided by law.
