

RESOLUTION NO. 1

Authorizing the use of Liquid Fuels Tax Fund by the Borough of Mill Village for the purpose of maintenance and repair of existing roads and streets of the Borough.

WHEREAS, under the provisions of **the** Act of March 27, 1980, P.L. No. 20, which amends Section 4, Paragraph 2 of the Act of June 1, 1956, P. L. (1955) 1844, 72 P.S. 2615.4 (2), relating to the use of Liquid Fuels Tax Funds by municipalities, the Mill Village Borough is authorized to use all of the funds allocated to the Borough, including the twenty-five percent otherwise allocated to the Borough for the construction, reconstruction and widening of roads and streets, bridges and drainage structures and for the lining of streams, upon the adoption of a Resolution authorizing that the twenty-five percent of the Liquid Fuels Tax moneys set aside for new construction be used for the purpose of maintenance and repair, after the holding of a hearing to provide opportunity for public comment before action is taken.

NOW THEREFORE, THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MILL VILLAGE, RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

That the Borough Council approves that in the year 1981, twenty-five percent of Liquid Fuels Tax moneys otherwise required to be used for road and street improvement may be used for the purpose of maintenance and repair of existing roads, streets, bridges, drainage structures and for the lining of streams incidental to the drainage of highways.
