

**RESOLUTION 2 of 1980 OF THE BOROUGH
OF MILL VILLAGE, SITUATED IN ERIE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

#1. The Plan of Raymond O. Peters and Donna L. Peters, his wife, attached hereto and made a part hereof as EXHIBIT "A", has been submitted to the Council of Mill Village for approval.

#2. The said Plan discloses that a private roadway, thirty (30) feet in width, running adjacent to the south line of land upon which the Borough Municipal Building is located, is to be used for a roadway pertaining to certain subdivided parcels of land of Raymond O. Peters and Donna L. Peters, his wife.

#3. The said Plan discloses that said private roadway is necessary to allow access from said subdivided parcels of land to the public roadway known as North Main Street.

#4. The Borough Council of Mill Village determines that said private roadway shall be recognized and approved.

NOW THEREFORE, be it RESOLVED by the Council of the Borough of Mill Village that the private roadway, set forth in the Plan attached hereto as EXHIBIT "A", shall be accepted and approved.

Be it further RESOLVED that the private roadway, set forth in the Plan attached hereto as EXHIBIT "A", shall be recognized as a private street open to police, fire and other official vehicles, maintenance of which is to be by the private property owners within the subdivision, not being dedicated to or accepted by the public.
